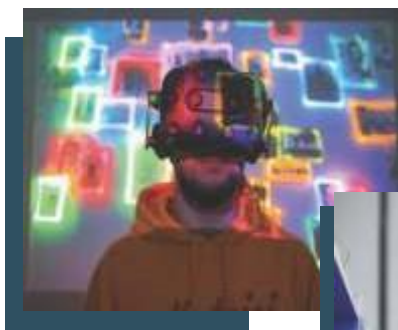


TBILISI CAMPUS

FACULTY OF MEDICINE

The faculty aims to train competent, patient-friendly and care-oriented doctors who will be equipped with knowledge and clinical/research skills matching modern international standards, who will be actively involved in learning, life span and contribute to the welfare of society.

The university has a Simulation Centre that oriented to develop clinical skills and allow students to learn and practice all the manipulations they will need for professional work through mouldages and mannequins. The equipment in the center meets international standards and is gradually updated. The clinical subjects are based on the British model and maximally serve the students to undergo practice with physicians operating in a clinical setting.

The university has: Chemistry/Biochemistry, Physiological and Microbiological/Immunological Labs, Histology and Anatomy Cabinets.

SIMULATION CENTER

The simulation center of Central University of Europe at the Faculty of Medicine, is a constantly updated, multifunctional department with modern technologies. The center is fully equipped with mannequins, simulators and the latest medical devices, which allows students to develop all the basic medical skills that will be part of their daily routine in the future medical practice.

STUDENTS PRACTICE CLINICAL CARE SKILLS, FIRST AID AND SURGICAL SKILLS, WHICH INCLUDE:

- Aseptic and antiseptic norms;
- Blood pressure, pulse and breathing monitoring;
- The principles of working with a cardiographer;
- Catheterization of peripheral vein and central vein;
- The skills of performing injections (i/v; i/m; s/c);
- To develop traumatic bending and immobilization skills;
- To study the principles of laboratory work;

3D VIRTUAL LABORATORY

ADMINISTRATIVE BUILDING

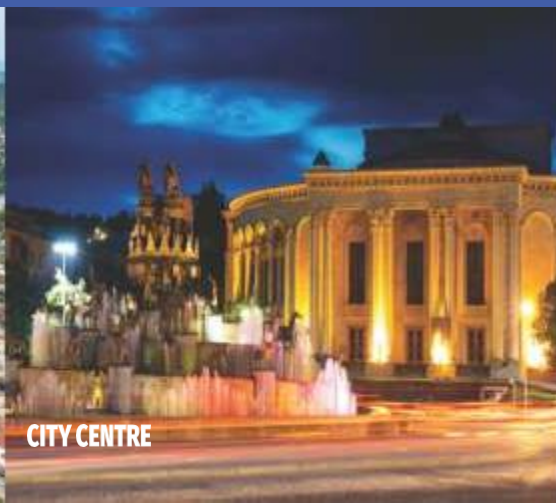
The administrative building of the university is located in the historical central district of Kutaisi.

Kutaisi, located in western Georgia, is one of the country's oldest cities and serves as the capital of the Imereti region. Historically, it has been a significant cultural and political center, once functioning as the capital of the ancient Kingdom of Kolchhis and later the Kingdom of Georgia.

The city is renowned for its rich historical and architectural heritage. The Bagrati Cathedral, constructed in the early 11th century by King Bagrat III, stands as a symbol of the city's medieval prominence. Although partially ruined, it remains a testament to the architectural ingenuity of the time. Nearby, the Gelati Monastery, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, showcases exquisite frescoes and serves as a reminder of Georgia's Golden Age. Perched on a picturesque hillside, the Motsameta Monastery offers both spiritual significance and scenic views of the surrounding landscape.



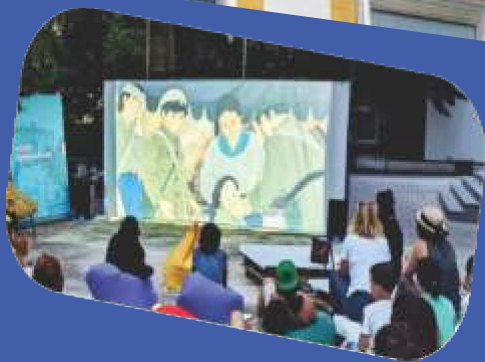

LADO MESKHISHVILI PROFESSIONAL STATE DRAMA THEATRE

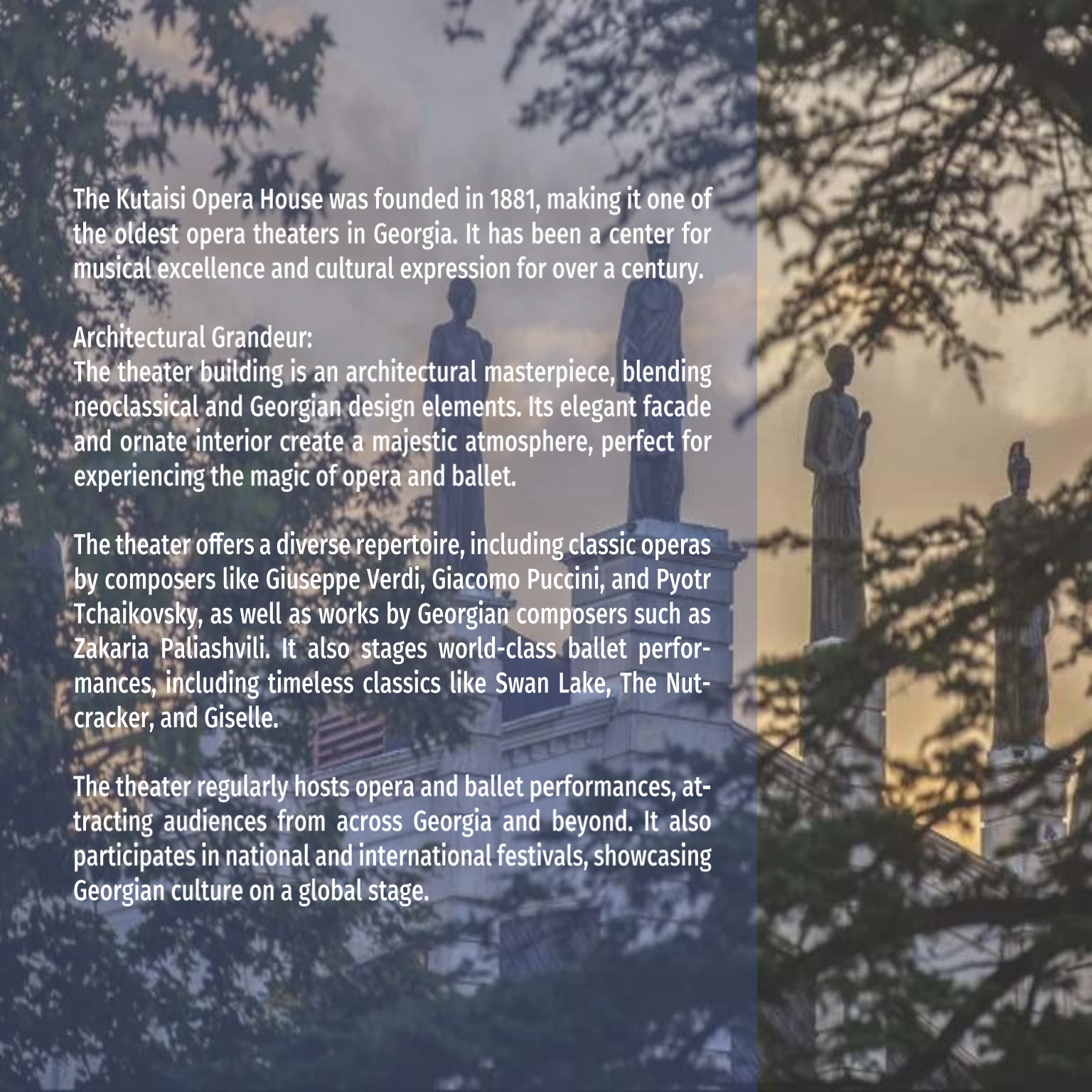
The Lado Meskhishvili Professional State Drama Theatre in Kutaisi is one of Georgia's most prestigious cultural institutions, named after the renowned Georgian actor and director Lado Meskhishvili (1857–1920). Established in 1861, it is one of the oldest theaters in Georgia and has played a significant role in the development of Georgian performing arts.

KUTAIISI OPERA AND BALLET STATE THEATER

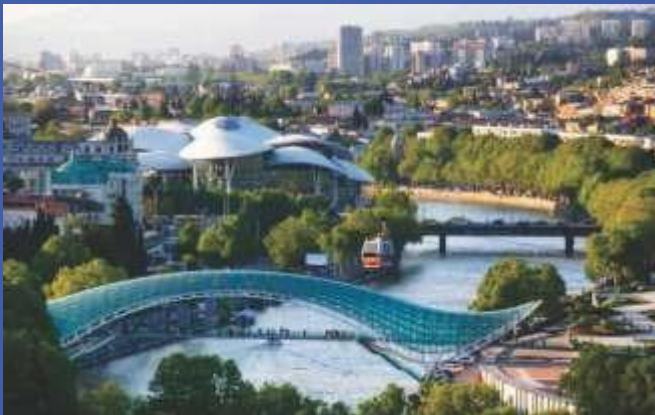
